

## **Metro Missions**

The Metro Missions program of the North American Missions division exists to facilitate and promote church planting in North America's metropolitan areas. Currently, Metro Missions supports Metro Missionaries who are endeavoring to evangelize and disciple millions of people in 39 metropolitan areas.

Metro Missions is one of the most successful ministries in the history of the U.P.C.I. Of the 34 Metro Missionaries who have completed deputation and arrived onsite, 25 have established churches that are still part of the U.P.C.I. That is a 74% success rate!

Those 25 Metro Missionaries have, in turn, planted 25 U.P.C.I. daughter works! That is a 147% success rate!

Additionally, 12 churches have been started by 2 Intracultural Missionaries. In total, 36 Metro/Intracultural Missionaries have birthed 62 U.P.C.I. churches. That is a 172% success rate!

For over 25 years, Metro Missions has established a proven track record. It is a successful tool of evangelism in reaching the metro cities of North America.

The sheer mass of people in the metropolitan areas of North America is mind numbing. The lack of U.P.C.I. churches in these same areas is heart breaking.

There are 10 foreign countries that have more U.P.C.I. churches/preaching points per capita than Louisiana, our most evangelized district in North America. There are 27 foreign countries with more churches/preaching points than Houston, TX, our most evangelized metropolitan city. There are 75 countries that have more U.P.C.I. churches/preaching points per capita than New York City.
